

OTT TERMS & CONDITIONS

RIDERS HIRING:

1. Riders hiring OTT bikes must hold a full motorcycle licence and bring it with them for inspection prior to their ride.
2. Riders hiring OTT bikes must be aged 25 or over.
3. Riders hiring OTT bikes will be asked to read, understand and sign a disclaimer and a 'Hire Safety Checklist' prior to their ride
4. **All riders hiring OTT bikes must surrender a £100 cash damage waver prior to their ride.** Scratches and minor dents are all part of trail riding and will be ignored, but breakages must be paid for. It is important therefore to check your bike for damage prior to departure. The maximum extent of your liability is £100. OTT will only seek to recover costs, and wherever possible will pass on any trade discounts gained to customers. If you have damaged your hire bike to the point of it being impossible to continue, then your day will be deemed to be over.
5. Riders hiring OTT bikes do so under OTT's insurance on a 'third party fire and theft' basis, legally entitling them to ride OTT's bikes. There is no personal injury cover as riders undertake trail riding at their own risk. Therefore personal injury insurance is the responsibility of the rider hiring.
6. In the unlikely event of a technical problem with an OTT hire bike your ride is cancelled or cut short, you will be offered an alternative riding date or a pro-rata refund.
7. All driving related fines are the responsibility of the rider concerned.

RIDERS RIDING THEIR OWN BIKES:

1. All owner riders will be asked to sign a disclaimer prior to their ride.
2. OTT expects all owner riders to be fully licensed and their bikes to be insured and taxed as for the road.
3. It is not OTT's responsibility to check each and every bike for suitability or legality. However excessively noisy exhaust pipes will not be tolerated.
4. Personal injury, or damage to your own bike or property is your responsibility.
5. Good bike preparation and protection is essential. Although OTT will make every effort to assist in trailside repairs or breakdowns, (and when possible recovery), your bike is not OTT's responsibility. Make sure you carry adequate spares and that your bike is fully ready for the trail.

PAYMENT

1. To secure your booking OTT will ask for a deposit of one third of the total booking fee. We take cheques or cash.
2. The balance must be settled in the morning prior to your ride
